**Andrew:** My main takeaway is how impactful/enjoyable their service is. It was so simple yet wonderful such that it made me slow down and think about our services back in Shekinah in a way that have we been too complicated? I really learnt that sometimes, being simple, is the best way to go. I've certainly learnt that God is powerful and mighty. He made it possible for Pst Prasad and Sister Abigail to be able to raise their 2 kids and both are now studying in universities abroad. He provided for them, the same way he provided for many others who were willing to let go, let God. The mission field is always fun because it's not just any ordinary holiday, but it's a holiday with God because by giving them what God first gave to us is when we know that we're helping God expand His kingdom.

**Dorothy:** I was surprised to see so many people turn up for the lessons and worship service even though many of them had to study and work at the same time to support themselves. In order to improve their quality of life, they are more than willing to pick up a second language. While in Singapore, many students take their education for granted and do not put in full effort to master their mother tongue. I also see the youths having the enthusiasm that I don't see often in the young people of Singapore. The highlight of the trip for me was the trip to the genocide museum and the killing fields. I had a chance to visit and learn more about the horrors that the people in Cambodia had to go through. I can tell that many people were scarred and only God can bring healing and peace to the victims, their families and the land.

**Joshua:** Something that surprised me was the effort that the youth there put into their studies of English and Chinese as in Singapore you see very often the student take studying as a chore and don't really focus a lot on it, it really opened up my eye and make me realise my privilege and how I am taking the opportunities I am given for granted. I learnt that I should start taking my studies more seriously and stop wanting what others have as the youth there while not as privileged as us they are content and happy with what they have and don't cover what others have and take their opportunities very seriously and really put a lot of effort in their studies which made me realise how bad my attitude towards my studies are and that I seriously need to step up my game.

**Priscilla:** In this trip, I expected for us to value-add to the ministry in Cambodia, through our various skill sets, strengths and resources at our disposal. I expected myself to go with a willing heart to serve those we would meet, in whatever capacity. In addition, since it was my first mission trip in about a decade, I desired to see how precious God and the gospel are to those

who did not have the privilege of growing up in a Christian household, as many of the believers in our overseas partner churches are. We take God for granted, sometimes. It's still a journey of conviction to know that we have been gifted news that is genuinely good, and genuinely worth sharing of our own initiative, because each and every person needs Christ, and are called into purpose and relationship with him. Something that really inspired me was the earnestness with which the congregation worshiped. It wasn't that they had the best equipment but just this humbling posture of worship and lack of concern with the people around them, since they are truly singing for an audience of one.
